Bethel High Summer School for Credit Recovery - 2018

This summer we will offer various credit recovery online courses for high school students who did not pass the course during the regular school year. We are pleased to announce that these courses are available at a **reduced price.** The majority of the online courses have been created by Bethel High teachers who will be present to assist students as they proceed through the course work. Some of the credit recovery courses are available through the Keystone Online program (i.e. Civics and Personal Finance). The price is the same for both.

During Summer School, students are expected to attend class every day in the computer lab at Bethel Middle School to complete their self-directed courses in a proctored environment. Since Credit Recovery programs are created by Bethel High School teachers, students need to attend "class time" at BMS to receive instruction and support. Students taking more than one program or students needing to miss class (with prior notice) must continue their online work from home. **All course work must be completed by July 27th. No extensions will be granted.**

All course materials will be available online, with the exception of English course novels. These will need to be obtained by the student during the first days of the program.

Academic Integrity Policy: The highest sense of personal honor and integrity is expected of all students in the completion of their coursework. Students are expected to complete all work without cheating, turning in someone else's work as their own (plagiarizing), or knowingly giving false information. Students submitting work that is not their own will not be given credit for the course.

Registration Dates:

Due to the extended school year, registration will begin on the first two days of classes. Be prepared to register at BMS on July 2nd and 3rd and stay for your program.
